The Danby Marble Quarry is famous for producing exquisite marbles with exceptional performance and durability. Recognized as the most prestigious white marble in North America, Danby Marbles are featured on many historic landmarks including the Lincoln Memorial, US Senate Building and many other federal and state buildings. Located in Danby, Vermont this 100 year old quarry is the largest underground marble quarry in the world. The quarry's 25 acre footprint and 1-1/2 mile depth offers capacity of 180,000 cubic feet per year offering the ability to accommodate the needs of almost any size project.

This unique combination allows for the domestic production of beautiful marbles with a reduced carbon footprint and lead-time compared to the international alternatives. The Danby Marble Quarry sits within 500 miles many US cities such as New York, Boston, Washington, DC and Philadelphia. For those projects located within 500 miles,

Vermont Danby Marbles may help contribute toward regional material credit for those projects seeking LEED® Certification.



The Vermont Danby Marble Collection is also Greenguard Indoor Air Quality Certified. Vermont Quarries is the first and only marble quarry to achieve this certification for low chemical emissions.

# Color Palette



## Appalachian Green

Consistent green veining with subtle hints of Danby White.



## Crystal Stratus

Grey & green movement with a touch of peach crystalline veining & large crystals.



## Danby Gray

Predominately grey with patches of white veining throughout.



## Eureka

Medium to heavy dark gold and grey veining. Comparable to Calacatta.



## Imperial

Light to medium veining in soft grey and gold tones.



## Montclair Danby

Greenish grey diagonal veining, often used for bookmatching.



## Mountain White

Very white with medium to heavy grey diagonal veining. Comparable to Carrara.



## Olympian White

Bright white with light to medium soft grey veining. Comparable to Statuario.



## Royal Danby

Consistent frequency of grey muted veining.

# Performance
